## **Don't Forget Immunizations! Get Protected From Meningitis, HPV, Tetanus and Pertussis!**

Check with a family doctor about college vaccinations. The meningococcal vaccine protects against bacterial meningitis. The Tdap vaccine protects against tetanus (lockjaw), diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough). The HPV vaccine protects against human papillomavirus.

The Anne Arundel County Department of Health provides routine immunizations to youth 18 years old and under at area health centers by appointment and through walk-in clinics. See clinic schedules below.

Vaccinations are free; however, donations up to \$10 are appreciated.

**Students should bring a copy of their immunization record. Children 17 years old and under must come with a consenting parent or guardian.**
