

Instructions for Completing the Subdivision Perc Application

APPLICATION FOR SITE & SOIL EVALUATION FOR SUBDIVISION OF LAND

This procedure provides instructions for completing a Subdivision Perc Application for site and soil evaluation for subdivision of land in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. The information listed below corresponds to the items listed on the Subdivision Perc Application.

Type of Subdivision: Indicate the type of subdivision proposed for the property.

Number of Lots: Indicate the number of proposed lots you wish to create from this application.

Water Supply: Indicate the type of water supply existing or proposed for the property.

Item 1. List the owner name, mailing address for the Owner of the property by including the street address, city, state and zip code. Also list the home and work telephone numbers for the Owner.

Item 2. List the address of the proposed subdivision. Include the house number, street name and city.

Item 3. Transfer the 12-digit tax account number from your County property tax bill.

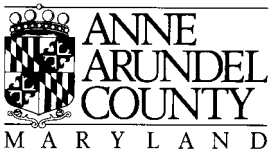
Applicant Information: Applicant must sign the application and agree to the terms of the application. Provide name and mailing address of the applicant in the box provided. The owner/applicant is responsible for contracting a licensed sewage disposal contractor, utility contractor or backhoe operator to schedule and perform the percolation test with the Department of Health.

Site Development Plans: Submit a site development plan including any existing septic systems or sewage system areas; proposed septic area locations (minimum 10,000 square feet); existing and proposed house locations and any other structures; existing and proposed water well locations; topography of property (2 foot or 4 foot contours); three percolation test hole locations in each 10,000 square foot septic area; neighboring water wells, septic or other sources of pollution within 100 feet of property. Plans must be drawn to scale (1 inch = 10, 20, 30 feet, etc.).

Application Fee: \$ 750.00 per lot. Make checks payable to Anne Arundel County.
