

A public health **Needs Assessment** includes the systematic collection and analysis of data to determine the current health status of the community. This guide includes resource links for health and population data organized by topic. Each major topic section includes a table of suggested resources as well as a list of common indicators with information about the data source and how to locate the data. **There are many more data sources and indicators available. You should also consider indicators from local data sources, special studies, and state and federal agencies, for example.**

What to Consider

When reviewing indicators there are several questions to keep in mind, including:

- How has the indicator changed over time and how does this affect your program? Many public data sources are organized by year; you may need to gather and organize the annual data to determine changes over time.
- How does Anne Arundel County (or your service area) compare to other communities (or the state and nation)?
- Is the population reflective of any observed health trends?
- What indicators are missing? What else should you consider in your Needs Assessment?
