This is a 15.4% decrease from the 810 overdoses YTD 2020.




## 2021 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 6.3% decrease from the 142 fatal overdoses YTD 2020.



# Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2021 (n=133)


