This is a 18.1% decrease from the 896 overdoses YTD 2020.




### **2021 FATAL OVERDOSES**

This is a 10.8% decrease from the 158 fatal overdoses YTD 2020.




# Hospital Encounters for Opioid-Related Diagnoses\*\* YTD 2021 (n= 327)
