This is a 18.8% decrease from the 1,001 overdoses YTD 2020.




#### **2021 FATAL OVERDOSES**

This is a 16.3% decrease from the 184 fatal overdoses YTD 2020.




## Hospital Encounters for Opioid-Related Diagnoses\*\* YTD 2021 (n= 327)
