This is a 20.4% decrease from the 309 overdoses YTD 2021.




# 2022 FATAL OVERDOSES


### Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2022 (n=41)






Substances can include fentanyl, heroin, heroin/fentanyl mix, opioid analogues and other opioid substances.
