This is a 22.7% decrease from the 414 overdoses YTD 2021.




2022 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 39.4% decrease from the 94 fatal overdoses YTD 2021.




Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2022 (n=57)






Substances can include fentanyl, heroin, heroin/fentanyl mix, opioid analogues and other opioid substances.
