This is a 21.8% decrease from the 634 overdoses YTD 2021.




2022 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 29.7% decrease from the 128 fatal overdoses YTD 2021.




Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2022 (n=90)






Substances can include fentanyl, heroin, heroin/fentanyl mix, opioid analogues and other opioid substances.
