This is a 1.1% increase from the 931 overdoses YTD 2017.




2018 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 14.4% increase from the 132 fatal overdoses YTD 2017.



Substances Involved in Fatal Overdoses YTD 2018 (n=151)




