2020 TOTAL OVERDOSES


This is a 7.0% increase from the 199 overdoses YTD 2019.




2020 FATAL OVERDOSES




Hospital Encounters for Opioid-Related Diagnoses** YTD 2020 (n= 151)

Fentanyl Test Strips

Anne Arundel County Department of Health's AA Power Program began distributing fentanyl test strips in the community in August 2019. To date, 1,320 strips have been distributed.
