2020 TOTAL OVERDOSES


This is a 5.6% increase from the 214 overdoses YTD 2019.




2020 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 12.8% increase from the 39 fatal overdoses YTD 2019.



Fentanyl Test Strips

Anne Arundel County Department of Health's AA Power Program began distributing fentanyl test strips in the community in August 2019. To date, 1,320 strips have been distributed. This harm reduction effort allows people to test drugs for the presence of fentanyl and potentially helps to avoid overdosing. For information, call 410-222-6724.
