2020 TOTAL OVERDOSES


This is a 5.8% increase from the 190 overdoses YTD 2019.





2020 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 21.2% increase from the 33 fatal overdoses YTD 2019.



Fentanyl Test Strips

Anne Arundel County Department of Health's AA Power Program began distributing fentanyl test strips in the community in August 2019. To date, 1,164 strips have been distributed.
