This is a 21.6% decrease from the 698 overdoses YTD 2018.




2019 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 27.6% decrease from the 116 fatal overdoses YTD 2018.



Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid-Overdoses YTD 2019 (n=84)





