



Gun Violence Intervention Team (GVIT)

Background

Gun violence is a public health issue on the national forefront with more than 20,000 gun deaths reported in the United States in 2021. Anne Arundel County is not immune. In 2021 alone, the county lost 10 lives to gun homicide and 33 lives to suicide by firearm. Almost 100 individuals visited county hospitals after suffering from a gun injury.

The Gun Violence Intervention Team (GVIT) formed in mid-2020 under the leadership of the Department of Health to address gun violence using a public health approach. The GVIT is a multi-agency coalition of city and county leaders. Through collaborative meetings and coordinated workgroup efforts with stakeholders and community members, the GVIT is implementing evidence-based, data driven strategies to prevent and reduce gun injuries and deaths in Anne Arundel County.



The majority of all gun fatalities in the county are **GUN SUICIDES**, each year on average.

For every one fatality,
THREE INDIVIDUALS
suffer from a gun injury
in the county, each year
on average.

Many gun homicide victims are TEENS AND YOUNG ADULTS, each year on average.

Vision

A county community where all residents are safe from gun violence.

Mission

Prevent and reduce gun-related injuries and deaths in Anne Arundel County.

Goals & Strategies

GOAL 1

Lead and coordinate aun violence interventions in Anne Arundel County and the City of Annapolis.

- A. Address gun violence as a public health crisis.
- B. Establish a collaborative body of government and non-government agencies to coordinate and implement aun violence initiatives in the county.
- C Participate in national gun safety associations and conferences.
- D. Develop a communication strategy to share aun violence intervention messaging, events. and progress.

GOAL 2

Monitor and advance evidencebased gun laws.

- A. Support requirements and restrictions for individuals to purchase a gun.
- B. Support temporary and permanent prohibitions for individuals to possess a gun.
- C. Support gun safe storage policies.

GOAL 3

Prevent gun violence through education and public awareness.

- A Launch an educational campaign to increase public awareness about gun violence and safety.
- B. Promote aun safety resources. training and services.
- C. Engage credible messengers to promote firearm safetv.
