


ABOUT OUR SAFE HOUSE

The Harry & Jeanette Weinberg Residence is our domestic violence safe house. It provides safe shelter in an undisclosed location to individuals and their children who are victims of abuse.

The home accommodates up to 40 residents and provides both shared and private accommodations. Community rooms include the family room, kitchen, children's play room, counseling offices, computer lab, playground, and more. Basic food, hygiene supplies, bedding, bus tokens, local phone, and internet service is available to all residents.
