END THE SILENCE ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

There is never one single victim of abuse and assault. Violence has a ripple effect. The effects extend far beyond the home, impacting the health of our community.

- More than 1 in 4 women will be a victim of domestic violence in her lifetime.
- On average, nearly 20 people per minute are physically abused by an intimate partner in the United States. This totals to more than 10 million women and men per year.
- 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men have been victims of physical violence by an intimate partner within their lifetime.
- On a typical day, there are more than 20,000 phone calls placed to domestic violence hotlines nationwide.
- Intimate partners commit 15 percent of all violent crime.
- Half of those who abuse an intimate partner will also abuse children in the home.
- 1 in 15 children are exposed to intimate partner violence.
- Children who witness abuse are more likely to be abused or abusive as adults.
- The cost of intimate partner violence exceeds \$8.3 billion per year.
- As many as 60 percent of victims of intimate partner violence lose their jobs due to reasons stemming from their abuse.
- 1 in 5 female high school students report being abused by a dating partner.
