



What is Cervical Cancer?

Cervical cancer is a disease in which cancer cells form in the tissues of the cervix, is the lower, narrow end of the uterus.

What are the Risk Factors?

HPV Infection

Early sexual intercourse

Multiple sexual partners

History of STIs

What are the Symptoms?

Abnormal bleeding (between periods, after sex, post-menopause)

Pain during sex

Unusual discharge (smelly, bloody)

Pelvic pain

Note: Early stages often have NO symptoms

Screening Recommendations

Pap tests: Regular checkups for cell changes

HPV tests: May be recommended

Early detection saves lives. See your doctor for regular checkups.
