This is a 16.8% decrease from the 840 overdoses YTD 2020.

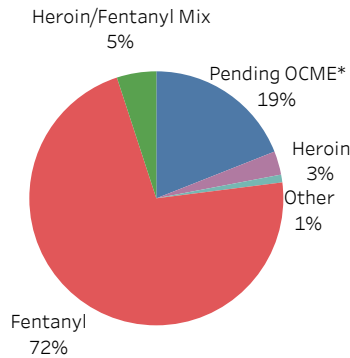

This is a 6.9% decrease from the 145 fatal overdoses YTD 2020.

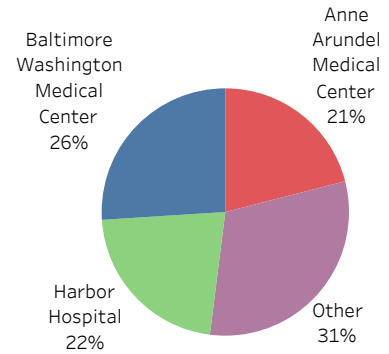

### Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2021 (n=135)



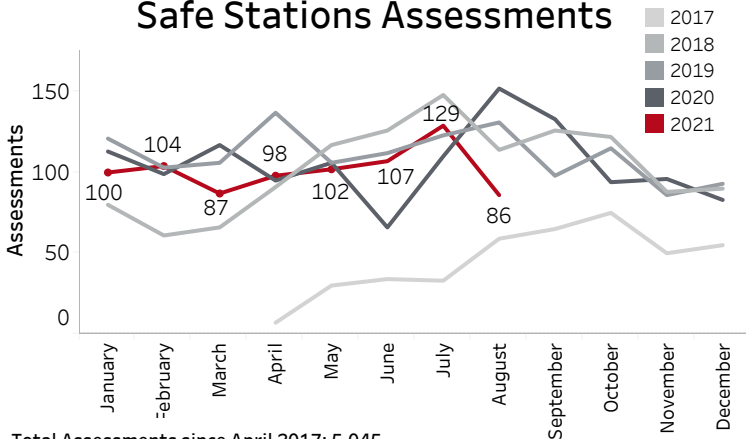

### Hospital Encounters for Opioid-Related Diagnoses\*\* YTD 2021 (n= 327)



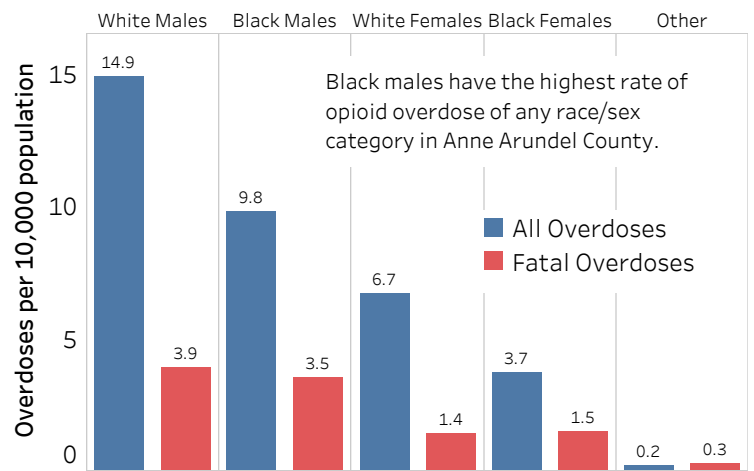

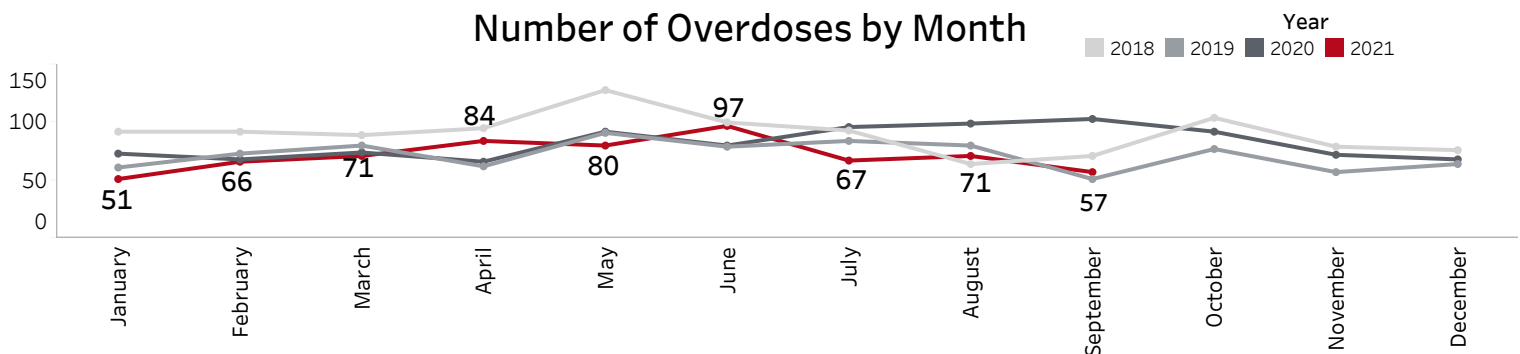

### Number of Overdoses by Month

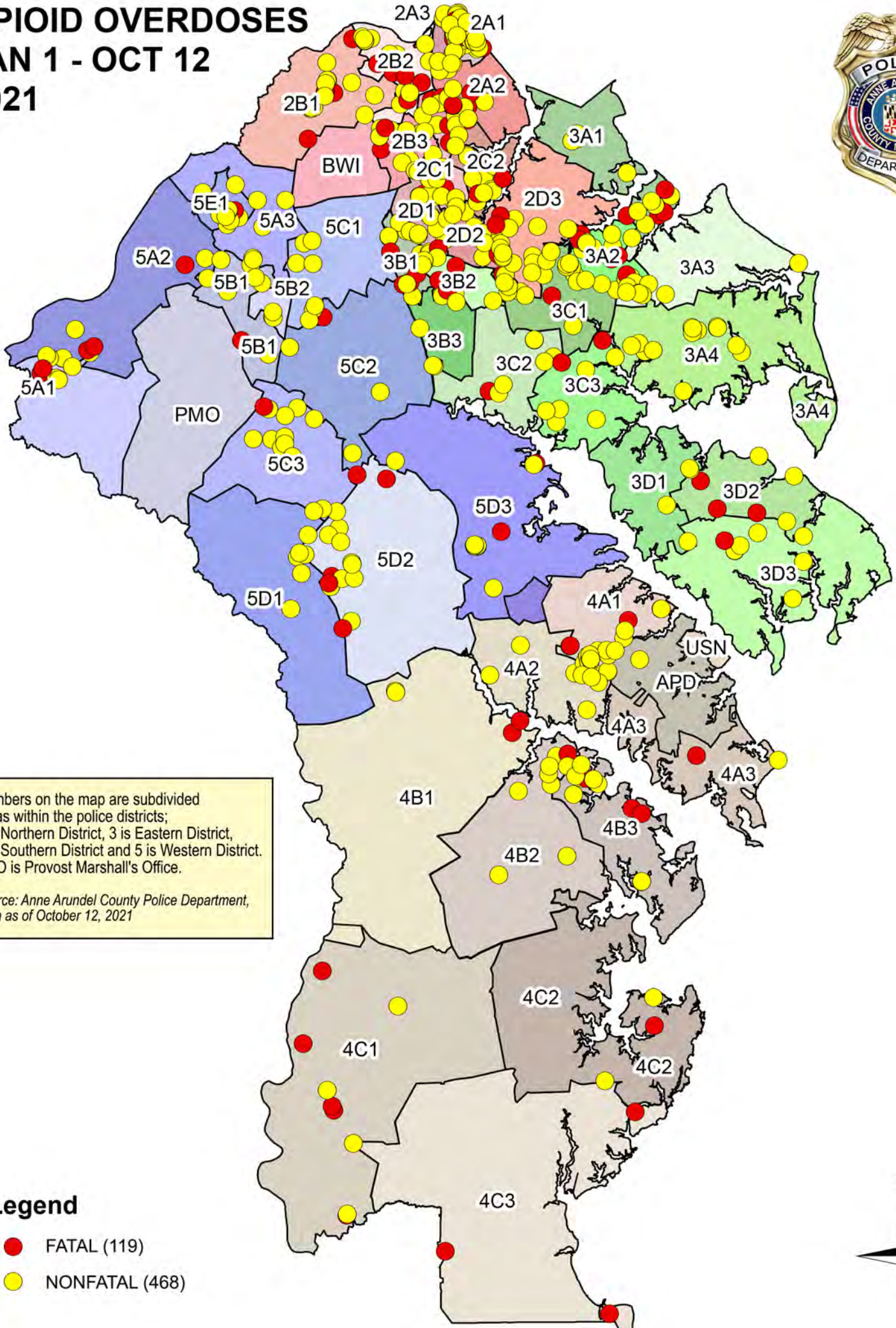
