This is a 1.1% decrease from the 901 overdoses YTD 2017.

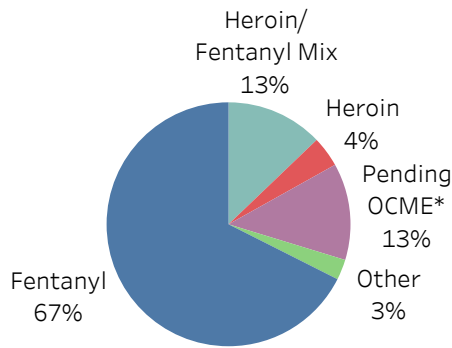

This is a 14.7% increase from the 129 fatal overdoses YTD 2017.

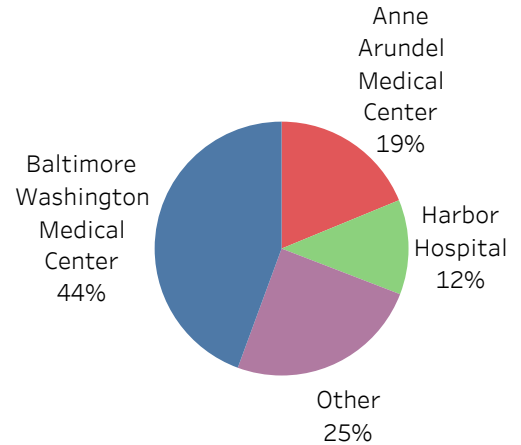

### Substances Involved in Fatal Overdoses YTD 2018 (n=148)



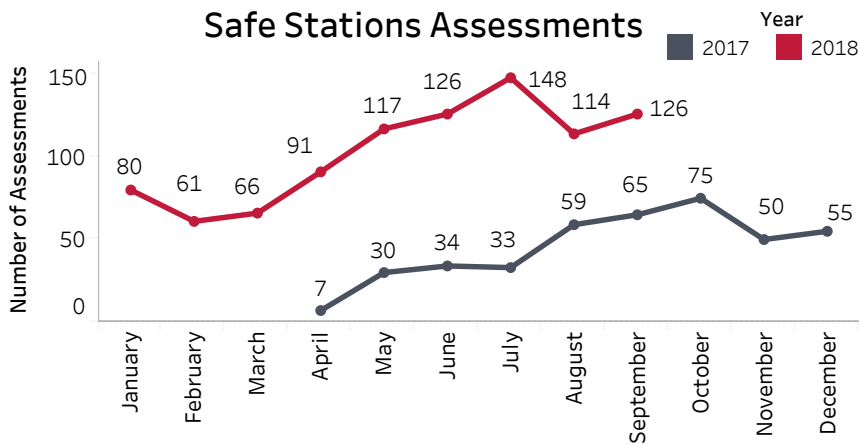

Since July 1, 2018

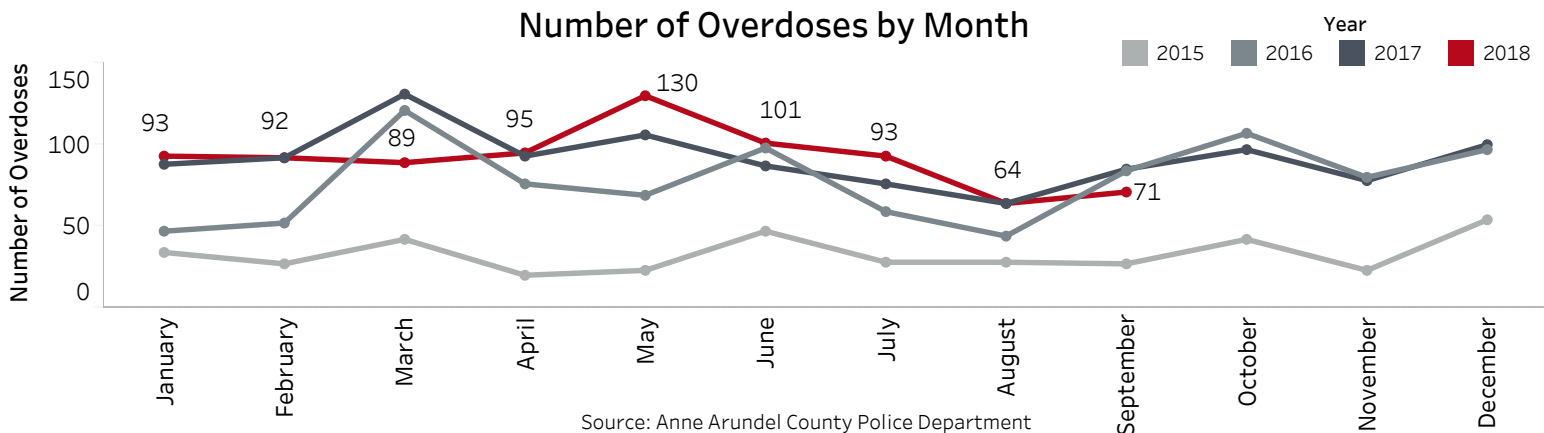
