This is a 1.4% decrease from the 916 overdoses YTD 2017.

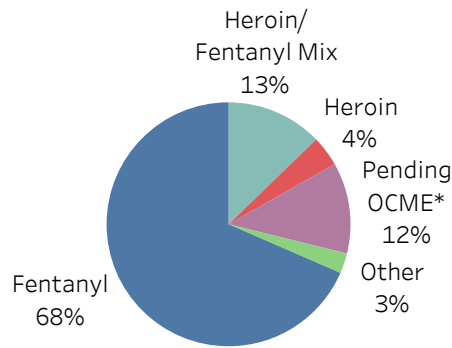

This is a 13.7% increase from the 131 fatal overdoses YTD 2017.

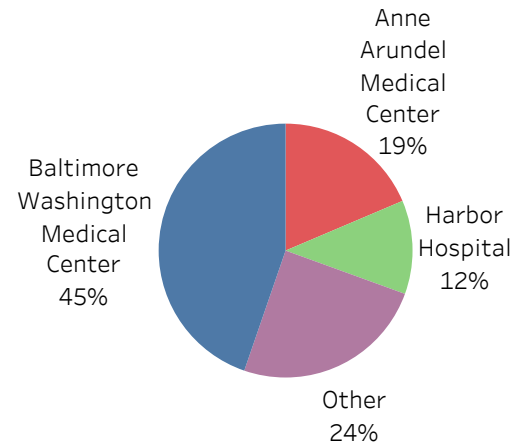

### Substances Involved in Fatal Overdoses YTD 2018 (n=149)



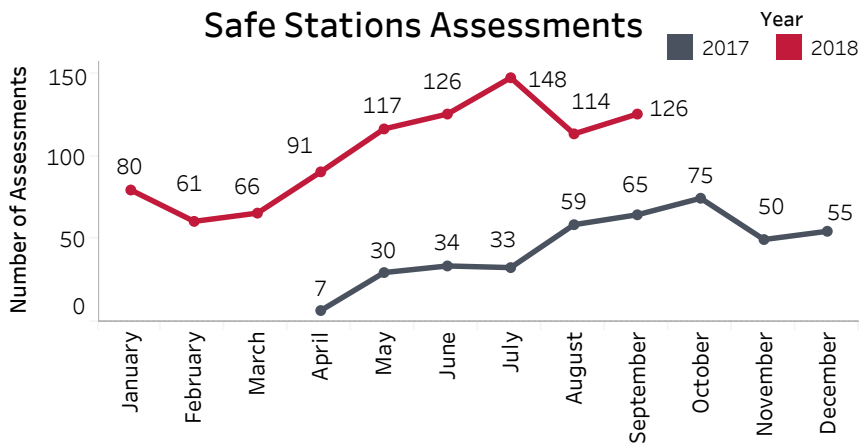

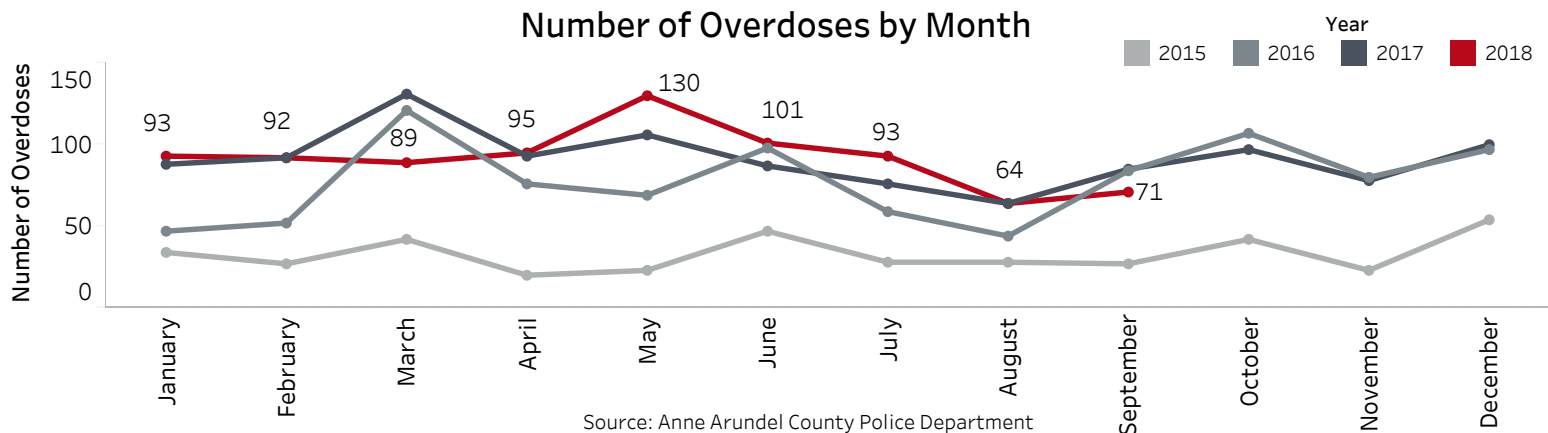

### Number of Overdoses by Month

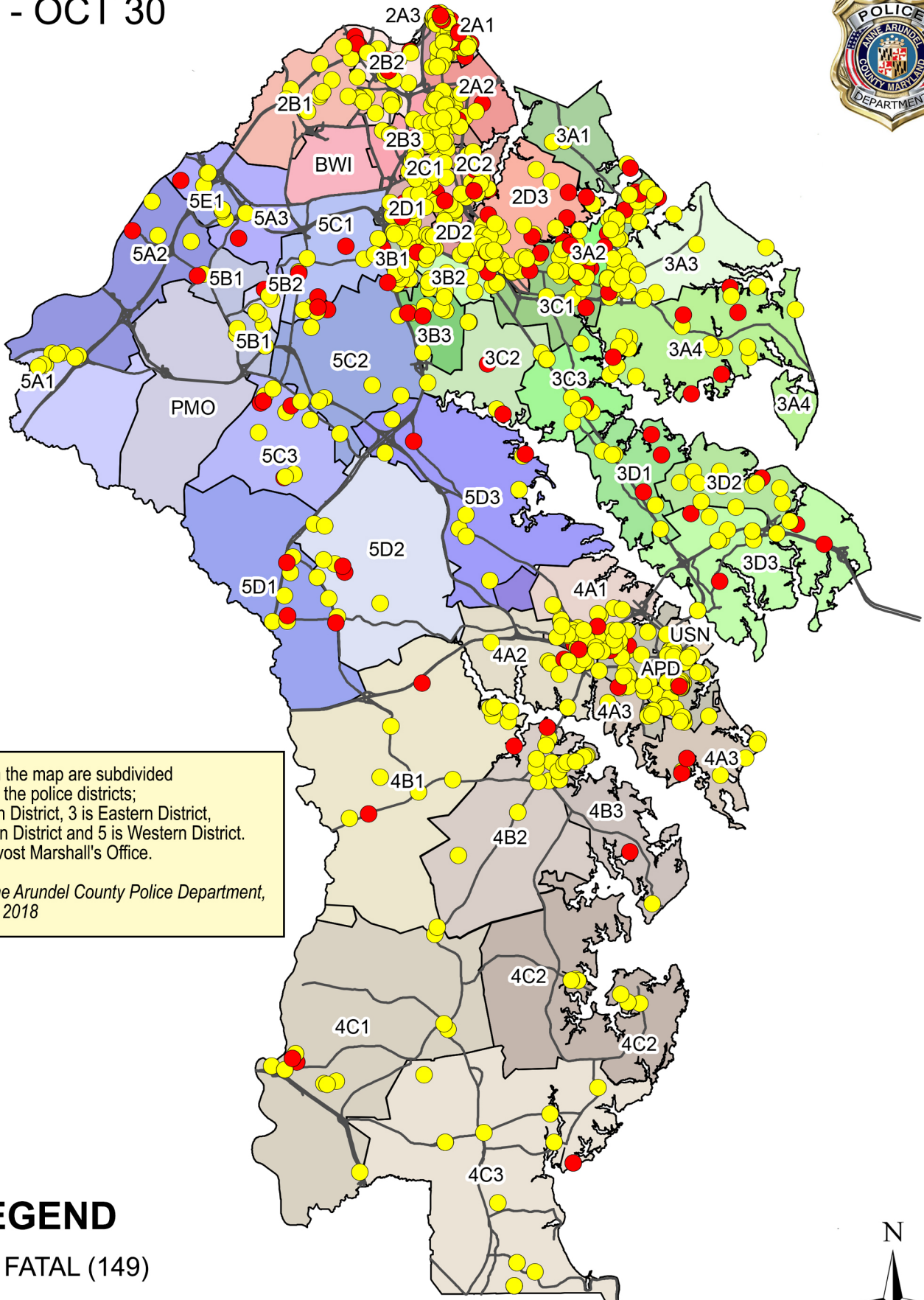
