This is a 14.6% increase from the 699 overdoses YTD 2019.

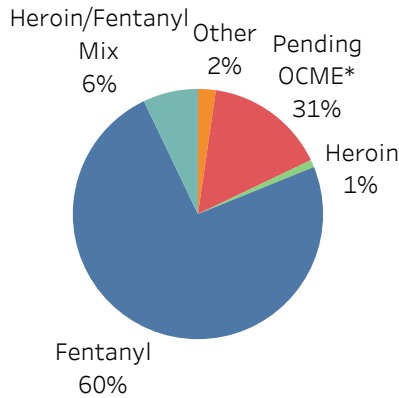

This is a 18.0% increase from the 122 fatal overdoses YTD 2019.

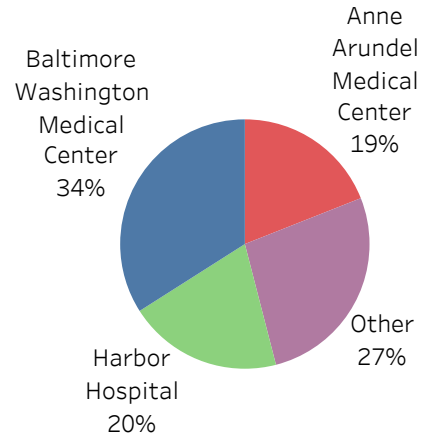

### Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2020 (n=144)



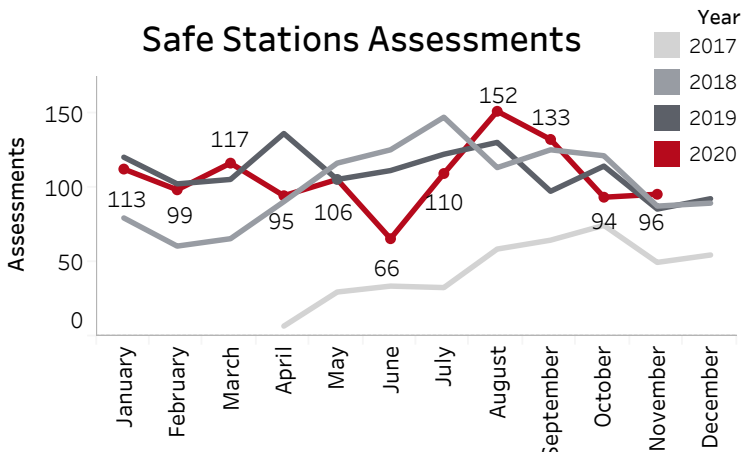

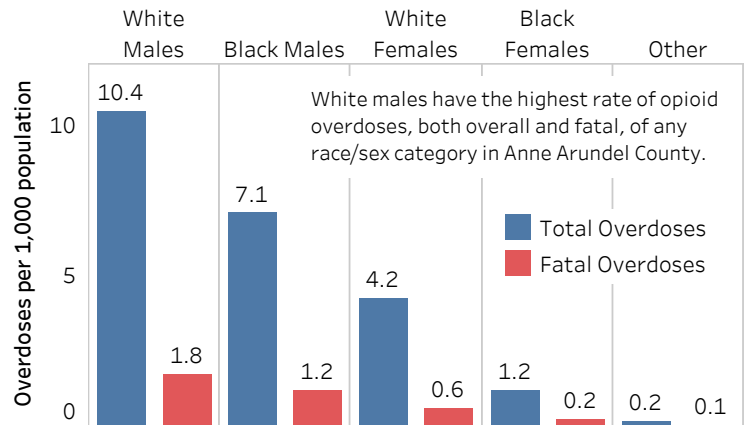

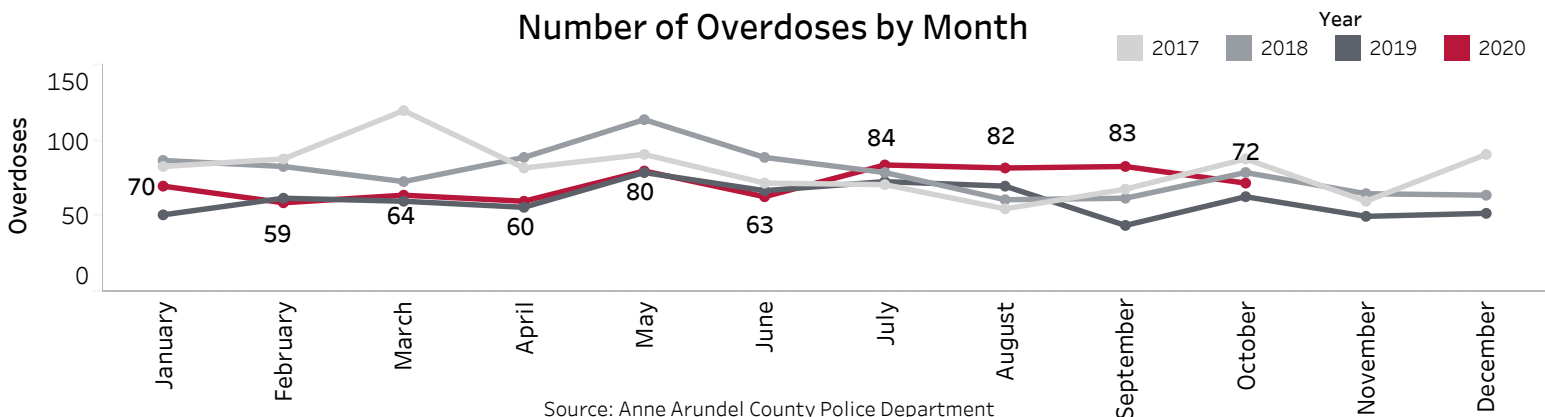
### Opioid Overdose Demographics

### Number of Overdoses by Month

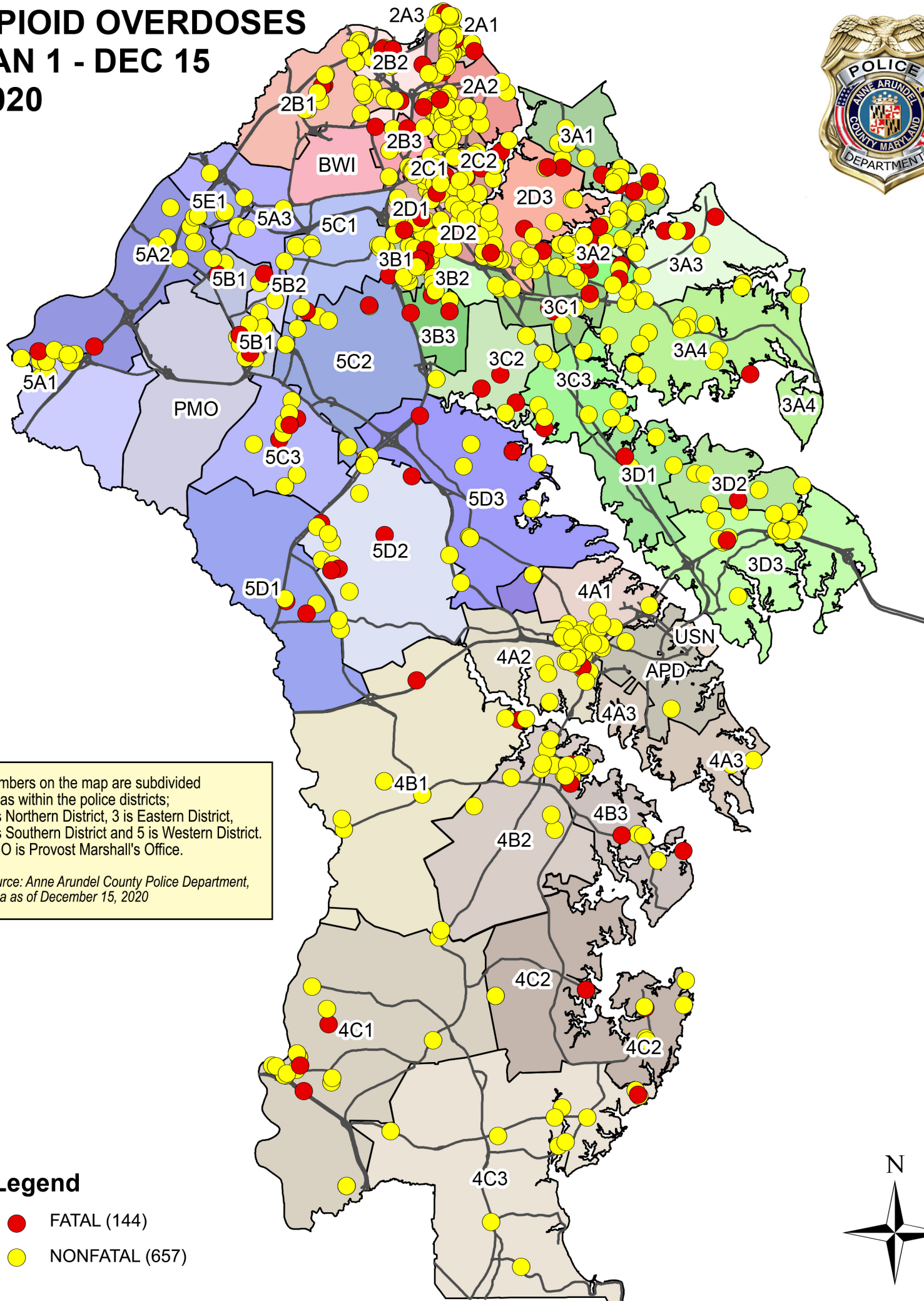
