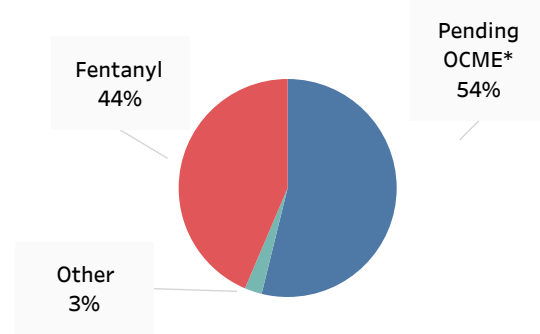


### 2022 FATAL OVERDOSES

This is a 38.1% decrease from the 63 fatal overdoses YTD 2021.

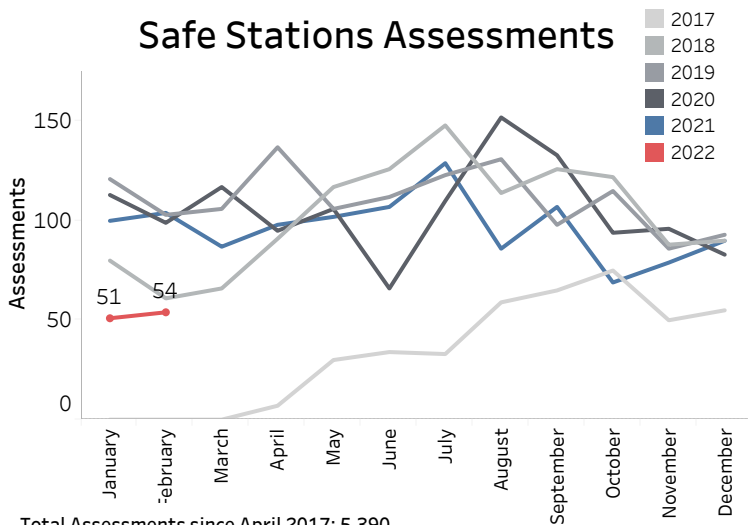

### Substances Involved in Fatal Opioid Overdoses YTD 2022 (n=39)



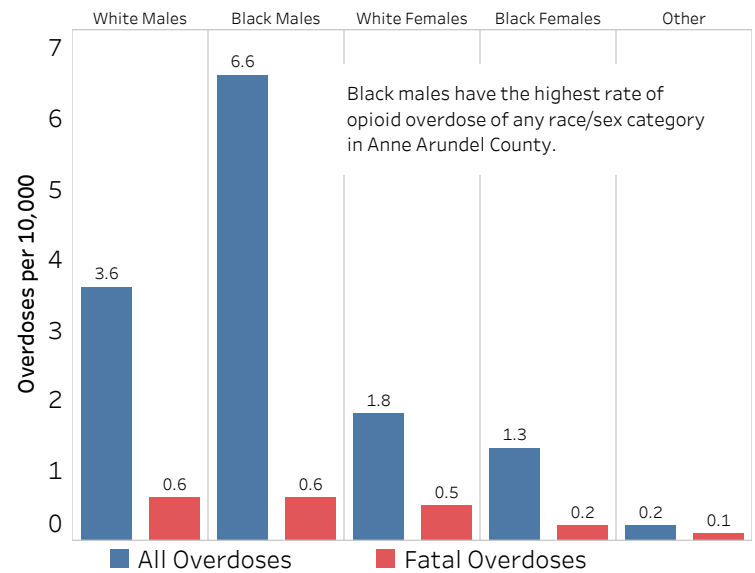

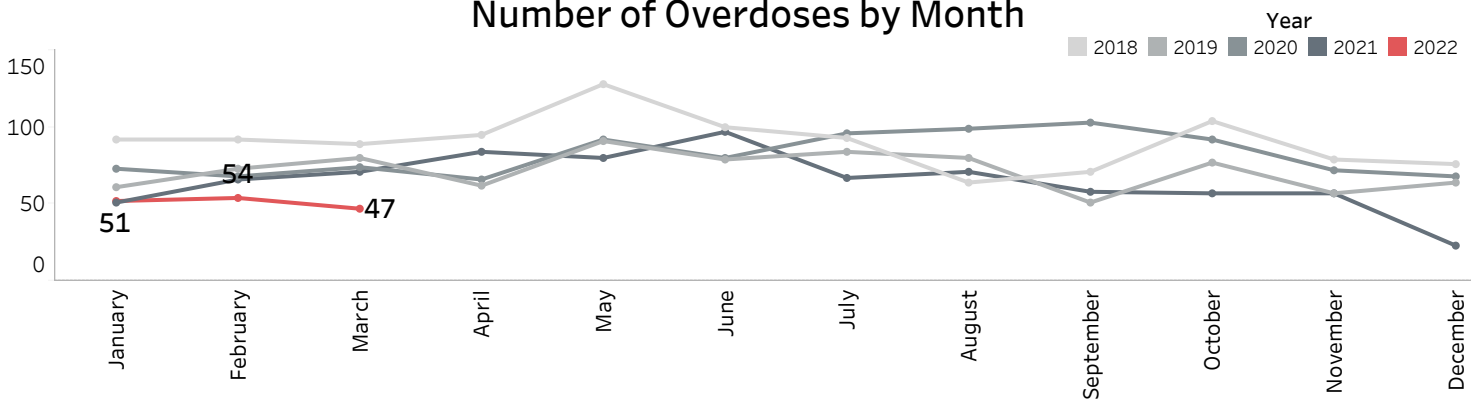

### Opioid Overdose Demographics, YTD 2022



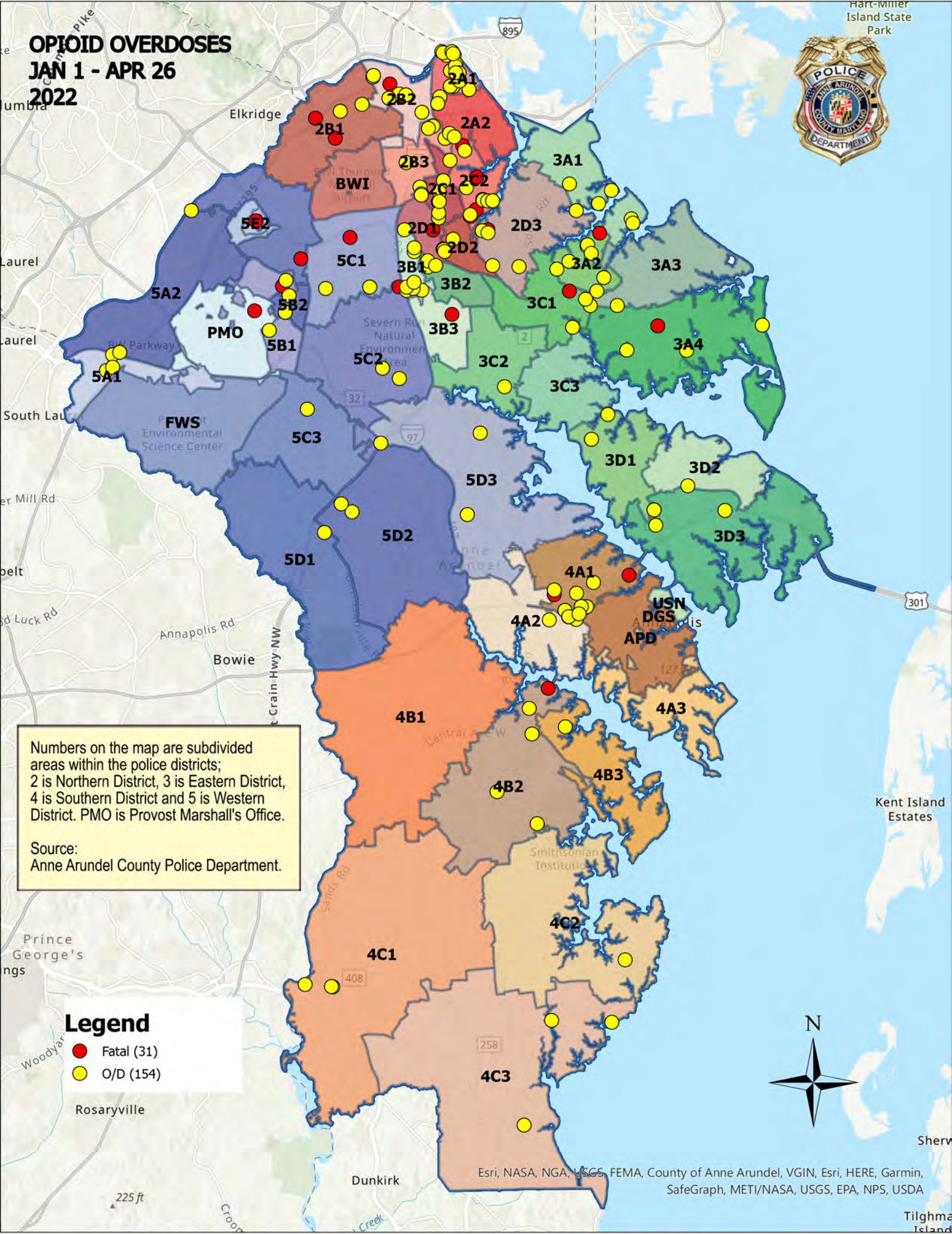
Black males have the highest rate of opioid overdose of any race/sex category in Anne Arundel County.
